



The Macmillan Information and Support Service provides a Support Plus+ service for cancer patients.

Using motivational interviewing techniques and supportive listening we will offer three, 1 hour Support Plus+ sessions, over a six week period. This can be over the phone or through Attend Anywhere video calling.

Support Plus+ aims to help you get back to a more active and fulfilling life by:

- Helping you explore your concerns
- Problem solving alongside you
- Encourage/co-create a robust action plan
- Revisit and revise the action plan
- Signpost or refer you to other support services

How do I access Support Plus+?

Your Specialist Nurse or Chemotherapy Nurse can refer you to Support Plus+. You can self refer, by using the self-referral form, or by ringing **01270 273603** and speaking to the Macmillan Information and Support Service.

What do I need to know about the Support Plus+ telephone calls?

The service will call you, so it is **free of charge**. Each telephone call lasts up to one hour and would be at an agreed time.

The Macmillan Information and Support Service staff will introduce the service to you and discuss your needs.


