

# General information for patients attending the X-Ray (Medical Imaging) Department

### **Parking**

- Parking can be very busy, especially at peak times. We ask that you allow plenty of time before your appointment for parking.
- If you require any assistance when parking, please use the intercom button to contact Security who will help you with finding a space.
- On arrival please report to X-Ray Reception, unless your letter specifies otherwise.
- Car parking charges for Leighton Hospital and Victoria Infirmary, Northwich are as follows:

Up to 25 minutes	Free
25 minutes to 4 hours	£3
4 hours to 24 hours	£5
Over 24 hours	£10

#### **Ambulance Patients**

• If you will be coming to your appointment by ambulance, you will need to contact the Ambulance Patient Transport Service on 0345 425 0050 to organise your transport. Please ask for a **prompt** appointment, to ensure that you arrive on time for your appointment.

## **Appointment Times**

• We will aim to keep any delays to your appointment time to a minimum; however, due to clinical or technical problems this may not always be possible.

# Items to Bring With You

- If you wear reading glasses, bring them with you as you may be asked to complete a questionnaire.
- All patients will be required to change into a hospital gown. You may wish to bring a dressing gown with you; this may help to make you feel more comfortable whilst waiting for your examination.
