What is the role of the Uro-Oncology Nurse Specialist?

We specialise in the care and support of people with cancer or suspected cancer of the bladder, prostate, kidney, testes and penis.

We work closely with consultants, doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals within Leighton Hospital, regional hospitals and the community. We will ensure that your care is consistent, co-ordinated and that your needs are met.

What do we do?

The diagnosis of cancer can be a very uncertain time in your life. We have specialist knowledge about urological cancers and treatment.

- We provide support and information to patients, their family and friends from referral to diagnosis, to treatment and aftercare. We hope to reduce some of the fear and anxieties that you are facing.
